

Spring Fling 2010

Scheduled from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. each day March 15-19, Spring Fling is a spring break ministry for Kindergarten – 5th grade students. **Deadline for all registration (this includes extended care) is Friday, March 5, 2010.** All registration and release forms must be filled out and signed by a parent or guardian.

Check in will begin each morning at 9:00 a.m. and we will be leaving at approximately 9:30 a.m. Please make sure that your child arrives no later than 9:15 a.m. each day.

You may pick up your child in Hedrick Hall each afternoon no later than 2:00 p.m. (unless your child is staying for extended care). It is imperative that you send a note with your child if they are to leave with someone other than a parent or guardian.

Again, this year we are offering extended care from 2:00-5:00p.m. at a cost of \$8/family each day. If you are in need of extra care, please fill out the appropriate section on the registration form. You must pre-register for extended care if you plan to use it.

All children will need a sack lunch on Tuesday. Lunch on Monday will be pizza, Wednesday lunch will be at Trees for Life, lunch on Thursday will be McDonalds and lunch on Friday will be at All Star Sports . Any child with food allergies or special dietary needs should bring a lunch each day. It would be a great help if each family could donate a 2-liter bottle of soda/juice for the week.

This ministry depends on volunteers to help with the kids, so parents/siblings 12 or older are encouraged to participate by helping with field trips, check in, or other activities.
